 - Participate in at least 2 club projects/events per school year
 - Maintain a 3.5 GPA or higher
 - Exhibit exemplary character and leadership
 - Attend 1 Senior Beta Club meeting per month
 - Pay a one-time \$32 dues. This will not be paid until you are accepted into the club.
