Grandparents are strongly encouraged to pre- register by February 28 to expedite the check in experience on the day of the program. On March 7, all grandparents and grand-friends should enter and check in through the Allen Center Athletics Entrance. Check in will open through the Allen Center Athletics Entrance at 8:00am and doors to Dotson Gym will open for seating at 8:15am. Parking will be available on campus and overflow parking will be available at One Church: Calvary. Shuttles will be running from One Church to PCA.

Who can attend Grandparents Day?

Due to space limitations, Grandparents Day is reserved for Grandparents and Grand-Friends only.

Where do I park?

Parking for grandparents will be available on campus and overflow parking will be available at One Church: Calvary in our Athletics Complex parking lot. When parking at Once Church, please park on the west side located on the left side and follow the road around to the parking lots near the athletic fields. Shuttles will be running from One Church to PCA before and after the program.

What entrance do I use?

All grandparents should enter through the Allen Center Athletics Entrance. The Athletic doors will open at 8:00am for check in. Dotson Gym doors will open at 8:15am for seating.

Will there be handicapped parking?

We will have several handicap accessible parking spots available. Golf carts will also be available to help transport guests to the entrance.

Is pre-registration necessary?

Pre-registration is strongly encouraged. Due to security protocols, all guests must be properly checked in through our check in system and will need a valid driver's license at time of check-in. To help with crowds and long lines the day of the program, we are offering this pre-registration to expedite your check in experience. Please fill out this form in order to complete pre-registration. All guests must pre-register by February 28th.

When will I see my grandchild?

You will get to see your grandchild perform in the program. Following the program, you will have the opportunity to visit your grandchild's classroom.

When can I get a seat for the Grandparents Day program in Dotson Gym?

Doors will open for seating in Dotson Gym at 8:15 am. Until then, you will be able to enjoy coffee and light refreshments in the Athletic Hallway after checking in.

What happens after the program?

Once the program concludes, you are welcome to enjoy coffee and light refreshments in Dotson Gym. We will have guides available to help you locate your grandchild's classroom after the program.

Can I check my grandchild out after the program concludes?

Yes! In order to check your grandchild out after the program concludes, your child will need to have a Dismissal Form filled out ahead of time by their parent/guardian. Once the program concludes, you will make your way back to your grandchild's classroom and meet them there. You will be able to check your grandchild out at that time.
