All PCA grandparents and grand-friends are warmly invited to save the date for our annual **Grandparents Day program on Friday, March 6 at 9:00am in the Jean Alyne Dotson Gymnasium**. Grandparents will have an opportunity to enjoy student performances, classroom visits, and light refreshments. Grandparents Day is a half day for all students. In order to ensure the safety and security of all students, **all grandparents and grand-friends will be required to check in through our visitor security system with a valid Driver's License or Government ID**. Grandparents are strongly encouraged to pre- register by **February 27** to expedite the check in experience on the day of the program. Due to space limitations, this event is for grandparents and grand-friends only.

Pre-registration is not required, however please be prepared to wait at check in due to the volume of visitors we will have that day.

## Grandparents Day Details

On March 6, all grandparents and grand-friends should enter and check in through the Allen Center Athletics Entrance. Check in will open through the Allen Center Athletics Entrance at 7:45 am. Parking will be available on campus and overflow parking will be available at One Church: Calvary. Shuttles will be running from One Church to PCA.

## Grandparents Day FAQ's:

### **Who can attend Grandparents Day?**

All grandparents of students in PreK - 12th grade are invited to attend. Due to space limitations, Grandparents Day is reserved for Grandparents and Grand-Friends only.

### **Where do I park?**

Parking for grandparents will be available on campus and overflow parking will be available at One Church: Calvary in our Athletics Complex parking lot. When parking at Once Church, please park on the west side located on the left side and follow the road around to the parking lots near the athletic fields. Shuttles will be running from One Church to PCA before and after the program.

### **What entrance do I use?**

All grandparents should enter through the Allen Center Athletics Entrance. The Athletic doors will open at 7:45 am for check in.

### **Will there be handicapped parking?**

We will have several handicap accessible parking spots available. Golf carts will also be available to help transport guests to the entrance.

### **Is pre-registration necessary?**

Pre-registration is strongly encouraged. Registration is not required however, it will help expedite the check in experience on the day of the program. In order to ensure the safety and security of all students, all grandparents and grand friends will be required to present a valid Driver's License or Government ID on the day of the event.

### **When will I see my grandchild?**

Many students will participate in the special program. Following the program, grandparents will have an opportunity to visit with their grandchild(ren). Once the program concludes, grandparents may make their way back to their grandchild's classroom and meet them there.

### **What happens after the program?**

Once the program concludes, you are welcome to enjoy coffee and light refreshments in Dotson Gym. We will have guides available to help you locate your grandchild's classroom after the program.

### **Can I check my grandchild out after the program concludes?**

Yes. Grandparents Day is a half day for all students. Students may go home with grandparents following the program and classroom visits. Grammar School students must have a Dismissal Form completed by a parent/guardian on file in order to be dismissed with their grandparent.
